Edgecliff is the closest bus interchange. The 328 service stops directly out the front of the Club, with regular connections to train services on the Eastern Suburbs & Illawarra Line.



Edgecliff is the closest train station, less than 10 minutes walk from the Club. Services on the Eastern Suburbs & Illawarra Line run frequently from the CBD*.



Spectator ferry & water taxi pick-up and drop off on the marina is available**.

Sydney Ferries also runs a regular weekday service (the F7 departing Circular Quay to Darling Point).



The Eastpoint Food Fair carpark entrance is located on New McLean Street, Edgecliff*. Parking is available from 7am to 8pm for a flat rate of \$7.50.
